Examples of Illegal Jigs

An Illegal jig is a lead-weighted hook less than or equal to 1 ounce in weight regardless if it is painted, coated, or covered by some other substance or by attached skirts. You must use lead-free alternatives if your jig or weighted hook resembles any of these devices.



As RSA 211:13-b states, “Lead sinkers and lead jigs shall not include lead fishing related items including but not limited to lead core line, spinnerbaits, buzzbaits, spoons, poppers, plugs, or flies.”
